The Role at a Glance

Role Title: Fleet Lead

Where: Mostly flexible/remote, with occasional hands-on time in Wokingham

Time Required: Around 2 hours a week (can vary), more during servicing or repairs

Commitment Type: Ongoing volunteer role

Reporting To: Leadership Team

Teamwork: You'll have support — you won't be doing this alone

Why This Role Matters

Our vehicles are vital. They carry people, equipment, and sometimes even hope. Keeping them maintained, safe and legal is a behind-the-scenes job that makes a front-line difference. You won't be out in the woods with a search team (unless you want to be), but you'll be a key part of making every mission possible.

What You Might Be Doing

- Booking regular servicing and MOTs
- Organising small repairs or maintenance (we'll pay, you coordinate)
- Keeping track of insurance, tax and vehicle records
- Checking with team leads to ensure the vehicles are fit for upcoming operations
- Helping plan future vehicle needs or replacements
- Responding to occasional unexpected issues (a flat tyre here, a warning light there)
- Assisting in the recruitment and management of authorized drivers

You don't need to do it all alone — if you'd prefer to split tasks with someone else, we're happy to explore that too.

Skills You'll Need

- Organised and reliable
- Comfortable chasing a garage or booking a service
- Familiar with vehicles (even just personal experience is fine)
- Able to use a calendar, email, and shared folders (we'll show you our systems)
- A team player who's happy helping in the background

Search & Rescue experience not required. This is a support role — no boots, radios or hiking necessary (unless you want them!).
